The Clark County Board of Commissioners will hold a public hearing on Tuesday, the **8th day of July, 2008 at 10:00 a.m.** in the Commissioners' Hearing Room, 6th Floor, Public Service Center, 1300 Franklin Street, Vancouver, Washington to consider:

Approval of the Chelatchie Prairie Rail Trail Alignment Plan:

Clark County Public Works and Vancouver-Clark Parks and Recreation received a federal Transportation Enhancement grant to develop a trail plan for the Chelatchie Prairie Railroad corridor. The plan defines the overall goals, standards, and approach for developing a regional, multi-modal rail/trail system along the corridor. The plan considers 33 miles of possible rail/trail and includes elements for walking, biking, horse back riding, and rail excursion trips. The rail/trail will encourage economic development and provide users with a diverse experience. The primary goals for this plan include the following:

- Develop trail alignment
- Develop trail design guidelines
- Determine segment candidates for early implementation
